EDUCATIONAL GRANT REQUEST FORM

MAS is pleased to offer an education grant to its members as part of the society educational activity. The grant is designed to give MAS Members an opportunity to visit a Teaching Center to learn more about the current practice of arthroscopic surgery from well-respected experts in the field. The knowledge learned by the fellows can then be applied locally to improve patient care and advance the local teaching of arthroscopic surgery. The amount to be awarded is subject to availability of total amount in the fund. Particularly for training program, the fund is intended to be used to cover a part or more of the whole program. Besides the training program, the grant shall also be considered for use to cover members attending MAS-approved conferences or courses abroad.

Educational grant request form should be submitted for approval ***60 days before*** the date of the training program / conferences / courses. Each request is evaluated on the individual's merits towards the society and is reviewed by the Education Committee for approval.

Criteria for Educational Grant Requests:

A. Fellowship Program

- Must be a Malaysian Citizen.
- Must be a life member of MAS.
- Must be enrolled in a fellowship program – priority will be given to trainee in local fellowship program
- Applicable only to training program for a minimum of 6 months and above in Arthroscopy and Sports related surgery.
- Actively involved in publication and presentation-both locally and internationally.
- Able to converse in English and Bahasa Malaysia fluently.
- No disciplinary action.
- Must have a good referee report.
- Must have a valid APC.
- Must be registered with National Specialist Registry (NSR).
- Priority will be given to those who have never received any education grant from MAS in the past.

B. MAS-approved Conferences / Courses Abroad

- Must be a Malaysian Citizen.
- Must be an active member of MAS.
- Actively involved in publication and presentation-both locally and internationally.
- Able to converse in English and Bahasa Malaysia fluently
- Must have a valid APC.
- Must be registered with National Specialist Registry (NSR)
- Preference will be given to those who have not received sponsorship from MAS before.

Required Documents Checklist for Educational Grant Requests:

- Signed educational grant request form
- Letter of Request outlining your fellowship program, the specific amount of educational grant being requested, the purpose of the educational grant, justification / breakdown of the educational grant requested.
- Curriculum Vitae with photo
- Full programme / brochure / announcement for the program / conference / course, if available.
